The Heritage Players will take us back to the Thirties

The second week in November sees The Heritage Players putting on their annual show. This year it is a night at a cabaret, 30s-style. Tairua Bowling Club will become the venue for 'The Auckland Cabaret' - with a cast of over 20 performers providing lively entertainment of songs, dances and skits, all introduced by two 'sophisticated' compères, George and Trilby.

The show, 'Back to the 30s - A Night at the Cabaret' has been written by Auriol Farguhar, with additional skits contributed by local writers Pam Ferla, Jenny Healey and Jeanine Stanley. It promises to be a fun-filled evening!

Auriol explained that the Heritage Players try to include aspects of New Zealand's and Tairua's pasts in their productions, and this show is no different. This year they are experimenting with a new way of bringing that history alive.

The 1930s were not all 'beer and skittles'; it was a decade of high fashion, of poverty, of rich high society, the growth of Hollywood and fabulous songs, but also a time of depression. It was also a time when Tairua was a very small village. Auriol is keen that we come along to enjoy the entertainment while learning something about New Zealand and Tairua in that decade.

"Back to the 30s - A Night at the Cabaret" will be performed at Tairua Bowling Club on Wednesday 13th, Thursday 14th and Saturday 16th of November from 7pm. The doors open at 6.30pm. The bar will also be open then for liquid refreshments. A

I was born and bred in Auckland and on leaving school, completed an arborist apprenticeship, and then joined the NZ Police.

After Police College, I was posted to Kaikohe in the mid-North. I have whanau in the mid-North and it was great to give back to the community.

When I saw the job for Tairua advertised I didn't hesitate, and applied. I have whanau residing in Pauanui and I spent all my holidays, whilst at school, enjoying what Pauanui/Tairua had to offer.

My interests are fishing, and playing rugby and cricket. I have played for the NZ police cricket team, and cricket in the mid-North.

I am very much looking forward to joining Dylan and the rest of the Police team in the area, being part of and giving back to the local communities, and getting to know the people."

[Constable Dylan continues...] Since Fraser's departure in January, Tim's appointment to Tairua has certainly been welcomed. At the time of writing, we are waiting to hear about a start date, but I anticipate it will be only a matter of weeks. I hope you will join me in welcoming Tim to our community and I intend to get around to introduce Tim to many of our stakeholders in the area, so don't be afraid to have a chat. We don't want to scare Tim off too soon - so if we could get a message to

During October, two arrests were made at separate family harm incidents where allegations of assault were made. Two defendants are currently before the court.

A suspect has been charged with shoplifting after he was caught on CCTV at Four Square shoving meat down his pants. Despite previously being warned for the same offence, and being referred to our local food bank, he was unable to explain why he did not reach out again to this local welfare service. This has now landed him in court.

The Tairua ANPR camera alerted us to a stolen vehicle from Auckland travelling through town, which was stopped on Main Road. The driver was spoken to and the investigation was solved without incident.

Tairua Security jumped into action when they responded to an alarm activation at a Tairua address and caught a burglar pink handed! The 37-year-old suspect was short of excuses to explain why he was wearing pink rubber gloves, after being caught at the scene by security. With the information provided by Tairua Security, the suspect, who was also wanted for breaching bail, was later apprehended. He was subsequently remanded in custody.


