Tairua baches book launching at **Anniversary weekend**

While we've all been relaxing over summer, Tairua Heritage Society has been busy! In addition to its usual gathering, collating, and archiving of historical material and relics, another local history book has been in the final stages of composition, and has now been printed. "Baches of Tairua: memories of bygone days" will be launched at St Francis House on Main Road at Anniversary Weekend.

The baches book actually began life in 2021 when Society Committee member, Nola Langford, was woken up one night by a truck taking away one of the town's old baches. She felt very upset that our town was in danger of losing an important part of our heritage as more and more of these old buildings were replaced by bigger, more modern houses.


Nola took the idea to the Society Committee which agreed that there should be a record of the baches still remaining in town before it was too late. Bach owners responded to a call for inclusion and local journalist, Pam Ferla, was given the task of writing up the stories of their iconic memory-filled homes.

The result is a wonderful

100 page book which has over 80 photographs, and is full of nostalgic memories of beach holidays in the 1950s and 60s. The early photographs of the baches, and of Tairua in general, are very interesting to say the least, and give a broader appreciation of the town's early development.

"Baches of Tairua: memories of bygone days" is the fifth book published by Tairua Heritage Society, joining "A Ship, a Bay, a Drowning" (2017), "Buried but not Forgotten" (2021), "Tairua Locked Down 2020" (2021) and "Tairua in the News 1960 to 2020" (2022).

The Society is hosting a launch for this latest book at St Francis House on Sunday the 26th of January, starting at 4pm. Refreshments will be


